ARTS & CRAFTS

Adventure Crafts

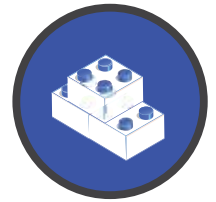
Handy Helpers *New class*

Lego Builders

Love Legos? This is a fun class designed to enhance thinking skills while having fun. Through the use of Legos and other building blocks, children will have the option of "free play" creative building or be challenged to solve problems while learning design and teamwork!



PERFORMANCE

Yoga

Kids yoga is here! A curriculum of songs, games, poses and meditation. Students will learn postures and practice balance, coordination, strength, flexibility and creativity. Kids Yoga also focuses on mindfulness. The mindfulness portion of the class will explore what it is to be aware of how they feel emotionally, physically and to be in the moment through breathing techniques, games and meditation.

Multi-Sport

Tournament time! Learn how to play team sports, including wiffle ball, basketball, floor hockey, and more, while sharpening your skills and having a blast!

Students will learn the rules of table tennis, along with the basic strokes, spins, and footwork required to take on any opponent!



Karate

Our instructor, a fourth-degree black belt in Tae Kwon Do, will teach students martial arts techniques to enhance their concentration and self-confidence. Karate uniforms, which are optional, may be purchased from the instructor.

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Please fill in the registration application in its entirety. Two forms need to be completed: (1) Registration Form and (2) Emergency Release Form. The Registration Form and Emergency Release Form need to be mailed in at the time of the registration. **No application will be accepted unless all areas are completed and signed on the back of the registration form. Be sure to register your child correctly.** Returning students or those with outside experience should register for advanced classes. Please adhere to grade level restrictions.

- All children must reside in the East Williston School District and be at least 4 years old by 12/1/18 to participate in the program.
- A disruptive/non-participating child will be removed from the class/program.
- Parents are responsible for notifying EWCAW of any FOOD ALLERGIES, as foods that cause allergic reactions in some children are incorporated into a variety of classes.
- Photos may be taken during the program and may be used in future brochures or our website. If you do not want your children in the photos, EWCAW must be notified in writing.
- **Parents are expected to pick up their children promptly at the classroom.** Any parent arriving late for pick-up may meet their child at the FRONT DESK. There is NO supervision outside the registered class times.
- Lost and found items can be found at the snack table.

If you sign up for a class and you don't hear from us, it means that the class will run as scheduled and that you are registered. Please come to the first session on October 20th.

REGISTRATION:

All residents will be enrolled in the order in which completed and signed applications are received by postal mail only. Registration is determined by our course offerings. It is highly recommended that you mail your registration form in early to avoid being closed out of a class, or having a class canceled due to low enrollment.

Unless you are otherwise notified, please assume your registration has been completed as requested.

Class and Registration Fees:

All 1 hour classes are \$140*. There is a \$15 registration fee per family. There will be a \$25 fee for all checks returned from the bank.

Refund Policy:

There are absolutely no refunds. Late starting dates will be accepted only with full payment. Please also be advised that we do not pro-rate the classes.

Class Switching:

Switching will be allowed (space permitting only) until the end of our third session/class which is **November 3rd**. NO EXCEPTIONS.
