Clay & Crafts

Kids will spark their imagination as well as improve their sensory & motor skills by creating a variety of artistic projects made of clay & crafts.



Cooking *New Recipes!*

Learn how to make tasty, healthy treats in cooking class! Children will learn cooking techniques and nutrition tips while preparing and sampling a variety of different foods. Students should have their hair pulled back, and an apron is recommended.



Decorating Desserts

ART & DESIGN

3D Art *New Class*

Lego Builders/Origami

Through the use of Legos and other building blocks, children will have the option of "free play" creative building or be challenged to solve problems while learning design and teamwork! This class also includes Origami paper folding. Get ready to enhance the fine motor skills of young hands and see what artistic paper creations they will create!



Painting & Drawing (w/ Cartooning) *New Concept*

Do you have a budding Picasso or Michelangelo on your hands? Students will learn how to create their own art by learning new drawing & painting techniques. They will explore their creative side and show off their masterpieces! Our instructor has a passion for all things art. New this year, we will also include beginner cartoon drawing in this class!



Recycled Art

Recycled art is creative work that's made from discarded materials that once had another purpose. ... Young artists can take those materials and make them into something new.

Taught by an environmental artist, children will be able to participate by brainstorming ideas for new materials and interesting ways that they can be arranged, collaged, painted over, or assembled to create something beautiful. Get ready to think outside the box and draw outside the lines!

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Returning students or those with outside experience should register for advanced classes. Please adhere to grade level restrictions.

- All children must reside in the East Williston School District and be at least 5 years old to participate in the program.
- A disruptive/non-participating child will be removed from the class/ program.
- Photos may be taken during the program and may be used in future brochures or our website. If you do not want your children in the photos, EWCAW must be notified in writing.
- Parents are expected to pick up their children promptly. Any parent repeatedly picking up their child late may be subject to removal from the program. Please do not drop-off your child before the start of their registered class. There is NO supervision outside the registered class times.
